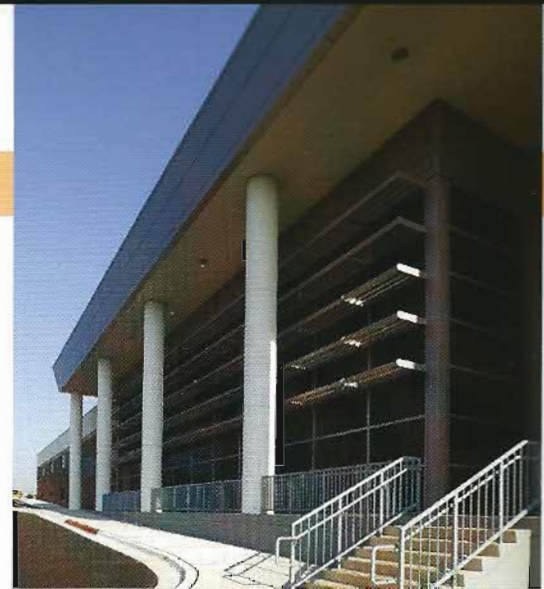

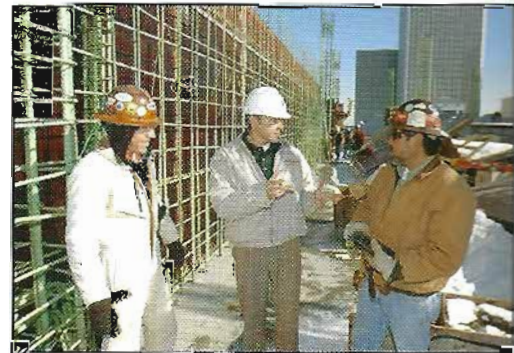




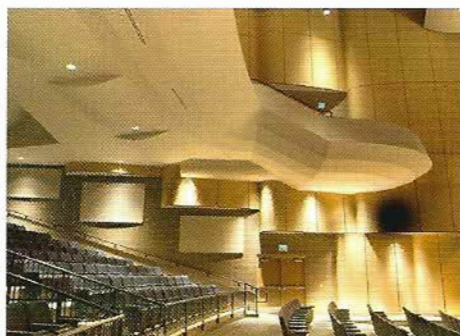
Five-Star Safety
